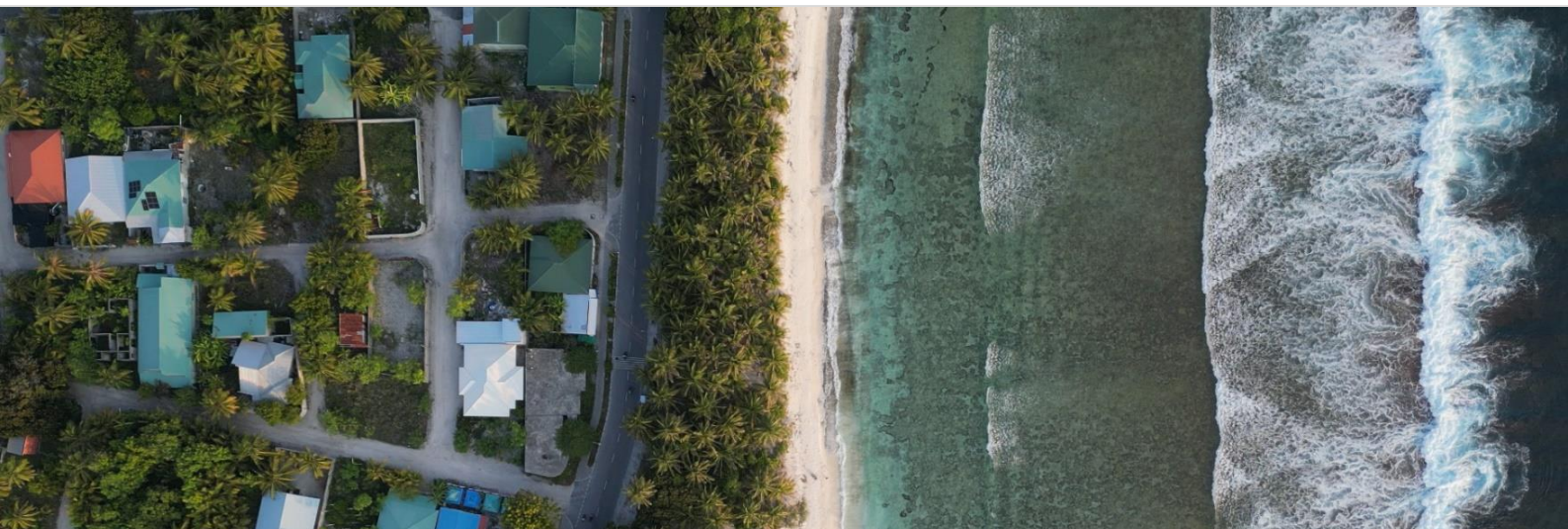
# FUVAHMULAH

## Fuvahmulah, Maldives

The Fuvahmulah Biosphere reserve is located in southern Maldives. Fuvahmulah, the unique island atoll in Maldives. Home of Tiger Sharks, Thresher Sharks and Hammerheads. The biosphere reserve is the country's only single island administrative atoll. This atoll boasts the most diverse coral ecosystems in the country with its healthy habitats and unique coral sand beach formations. This atoll is unique due to its single island and its bowl form.

Diving with sharks is exhilarating. You'll get to experience different shark personalities and learn their behaviors. I guarantee that you'll leave this trip more of a shark advocate.

Being a one-island atoll itself and the third largest island in the Maldives (if not for land reclamation), Fuvahmulah includes a diverse range of habitats ranging from tropical woodlands and wetlands to freshwater lakes, well-vegetated marshland areas, white sandy beaches of different variations and pebble texture plus gravel beaches and fertile lands of humus greater in area than any other island in the Maldives.







## SCUBA DIVING

The main activity and reason for your visit to the Maldives. Fuvahmulah is on par with the other islands on the equator, like the Galapagos and Cocoa, and absolutely should not be missed if you're serious about diving.

Dive sites are located between 10 to 20 minutes by boat depending on the dive. After each dive, you will make your way back to the dive center to grab a snack and refreshments.

You have the option of skipping any dive you want, you're on holiday after all! The dive center will be ready to pick up those that want to join on the later dives of the day.

## LAND ACTIVITIES

There will be lots of education surrounding sharks. From talks and a presentation with a marine biologist, this trip is more than just about diving. The knowledge and shark awareness gained, will leave guests feeling like they understand sharks more.

The local island of Fuvahmulah isn't your text book Maldives with hotel rooms on bungalows on stilts in water. It's a quaint island with so much to offer through it's diverse nature.





# LOGISTICS

## FLIGHTS

Domestic flight timings change monthly, so it's difficult to assess what international flight times to take. The good news is there are always two flights coming into FVM, and two leaving FVM back to Male. Depending on the international flight time you choose, the dive center will allocate a domestic flight for you.

## FOOD

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be served everyday at your accommodation. Lunch will be provided after your third dive. If you need a snack in between dives, there will be a café attached to the dive center selling tasty sandwiches for \$1. If you have special dietary needs, a form will be sent out to collect additional information.

## WIFI/CELLULAR

FVM has spotty, slow WIFI available if you're choosing to have your existing SIM card on roaming. The best option would be to go to the Ooredoo branch attached to the Male airport and get a local SIM card.

## VISA

Most countries in the world get visa on arrival. Passports must have 6 months validity from departure date. Kindly check entry requirements for your specific passport.

## CURRENCY

The Maldivian Rufiyaa is the official currency of the Maldives. The US dollar is also accepted everywhere, however change needed from a transaction will be given back to you in Maldivian Rufiyaa. Most major credit cards are accepted widely when shopping, however it may be useful to have some Maldivian Rufiyaa.
